We invite highly motivated candidates to apply for a postdoctoral position in the laboratory of molecular pharmacology (Dr. Julien Hanson) from the GIGA research center of the University of Liège, Belgium (www.giga.ulg.ac.be).

The position is for an initial duration of 12 months (with extension opportunities). The project aims at understanding the pharmacology and physiology of orphan GPCRs and will involve molecular and cellular biology of receptors as well as in vivo experimentations and small molecules screening.

The individual should exhibit **intellectual curiosity and creative thinking**. He/she will also be expected to have **good communication skills** and a **good track record in pharmacology**. He will actively participate in project management and experimental design.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATION:

- PhD in pharmacology, biochemistry, molecular/cellular biology.
- Strong hands-on experience in (molecular) pharmacology and cellular/molecular biology.
- Previous expertise on GPCRs, evidenced by publications will be an important asset.
- Habilitation to perform animal experiment is a plus.
- Proficiency as demonstrated by first author papers in peer-reviewed international journals.
